AII. 12 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

RESOLVED: To receive the apologies.

AII. 13 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

AII. 14 WAITING LISTS

The Allotment Officer explained that at present if people at the top of the waiting list refuse the offer of an allotment they remain at the top of the list.

RESOLVED: That in future prospective tenants could refuse the offer of 2 plots, then go to the bottom of the list.

AII. 15 HIGH MEADOWFIELD

The Allotment Officer informed the meeting that the Probation had completed the clearance around the garage at High Meadowfield.

RESOLVED: To inform the tenant of the adjoining allotment that the boundary of his plot will now extend up to the garage.
